- Mural

- When student SRC decided to spend money on a mural in 2020, was not possible. P&C helped by raising funds through Colour Run and Randwick City Council grant.
- Children chose design, and workshopped with mural artists
- Painting to start Monday
- Principal worked to get wall prepared with undercoat
- Tues, Wed, Thursday workshops with Mulga (artist)

- Infill then finalising — a week or more depending on weather
- 25m squared in size
- Principal has organised graffiti protection coat
- Outdoor Learning Space/Yarning Circle/Native Garden
 - Bee hive all ready
 - May have extra grants to help with garden beds — Principal helping to organise
 - Planter boxes may have to be removed for roof repair access
