

Principal's Report

May 2021 P&C Meeting

- Colour Run – Wow, what an amazing day! Achieved the aim of a fun community event and a significant amount was raised as well. Congratulations and thank you to all involved.
- Kindergarten students have had their vision tested. This vital program aims to identify any potential problems before they impact on students' learning.
- High School 2022 enrolment processes have commenced.
- Parent Teacher Interviews were conducted in Week 10. Whilst this is a scheduled time, a reminder that parents can organise to meet with teachers throughout the year.
- Events are back! Harmony Day celebrated our cultural diversity, funds were raised for Down Syndrome through Crazy Socks Day and there were fancy hats galore for our Hat Parade.
- Staff News:
 - Marena Lummow has been appointed as a permanent School Learning Support Officer. Thank you to Linh Medic who represented the parent community on the panel.
 - Mrs Molendowski gave birth to her son, Storm.
 - Mrs McBeth gave birth to her daughter, Saorise.
 - Staff have completed their 2021 Performance Development Plans (PDPs). These are reviewed mid-year and again at the end of the year. They are linked to DoE and school priorities along with individual staff needs, and guide professional learning and development.
- The Strategic Improvement Plan (SIP) was finalised and is available on the school website. The SIP will drive school improvement and decision making for the next four years.
- Ongoing development:
 - Walkthroughs, observations and interviews were conducted as part of the latest School Capability Assessment to determine where the school is with implementation of Visible Learning.
 - New Learning Environments undertook observations in our learning spaces and provided feedback to teachers regarding effective pedagogy and practice in the various spaces.
- Individual Learning Plans have been collaboratively developed for students receiving funding support and Aboriginal Learning Pathways for students from Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander backgrounds.
- Staff Professional Learning:
 - LEED (two Executive staff)
 - Beginning Teacher (three staff)
 - Bondi/Port Jackson Principal Conference (Principal)
 - SOLO - Structure of the Observed Learning Outcome (all teaching and support staff)
 - Administration staff undertook a variety of professional learning courses related to their PDPs



- Extracurricular:
 - Our school Cross Country was held last Friday. 32 students will represent our school at the ESPSSA Cross Country this coming Friday.
 - The school has registered for the Recorder Concert as part of the Festival Of Instrumental Music and the Premier's Spelling Bee.
- Funding has been approved for outstanding works including the installation of the substation. Currently awaiting DoE approval of the recommended contractor.
- Works continue on the back field.
- Concreting works out the front of the school were completed in the school holidays. A meeting will be held next week with Council to further discuss safety concerns on Fennelly and Young Streets.
