Recent Activities


- Welcome to all new families, 78 students commenced Kindergarten last week. We are expecting further students will commence this week once their Authority To Enrol is issued.
- Well done to the teachers and Admin staff who have settled students into their classes and learning environments so quickly. Staff (Executive and teaching) were asked to focus the first two weeks of the year building relationships and setting up structures, routines and expectations. It is vital teachers get to know the cohort of students in their learning space and students get to know their teachers. This ties into every student being known, valued and cared for. Homework activities and any group structures will therefore commence in Week 3.
